

COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE FUND (CIF) – FUNDING FROM MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL

A) CIF APPLICATIONS 2024/2025

1.0 Last year the Council made 2 Community Infrastructure Fund (CIF) 2024/2025 applications to Milton Keynes City Council for match funding for (in order of priority):

1. 2 x Combined de-fibrillator and bleed control kits for the Community Meeting Place and the new Watling Primary School.
Application to MKCC for match funding: £2050
Parish Contribution: £2050
Total Project Cost £4,100

This application was unsuccessful.

2. Community Speedwatch Equipment consisting of a road side starter kit with Bushnell Radar kit.
Application to MKCC for match funding: £283.25
Parish Contribution: £283.25
Total Project Cost: £516.50

This application was successful

The council has accepted the offer of £283.50 for community speedwatch equipment, prior to the deadline of 31 March 2024.

MKCC received 28 applications, with 16 projects offered funding in this round.
